

- ❖ General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) – 3 years diploma course.
- ❖ Bachelor of Science in Nursing (B.Sc Nursing) – 4 years bachelor degree.
- ❖ Post Basic B.Sc Nursing (P.B.B.Sc Nursing) – 2 years bachelor degree program.
- ❖ Master of Science in Nursing (M.Sc Nursing) – 2 years postgraduate degree.
- ❖ Diploma in Medical Radiation Technology (DMRT) – 2 years diploma course.

Nursing is a highly respected and noble profession that forms the backbone of the healthcare system. Admission Criteria

GNM (3 years)

17 years of age as on 31st Dec.

- ❖ The candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought.
- ❖ The candidates must have passed 10+2 with English and must have obtained a minimum of 40% at the qualifying examination and English individually for any recognized board.
- ❖ The candidates are also eligible from state open school recognized by State Government and National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government. However, science is preferable.
- ❖ The candidates passed 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in Vocational ANM Course.
- ❖ The minimum of 35% of marks for SC/ST candidates who have passed 10+2 with English.
- ❖ The candidates passed 10+2 with English having 40% of marks in vocational stream- Health care sciences from a recognized CBSE Board/ State/ Centre.
- ❖ The candidates registered ANM with 10+2 pass.
- ❖ Candidates shall be medically fit for the course.
- ❖ Both female/ male candidates are eligible to apply.

B.Sc.(N) (4 years)

17 years of age as on 31st Dec

- ❖ The candidate must have passed 10+2 or equivalent examination with Science (physics, chemistry & Biology) from CHSE, odisha or any other board or council or University equivalent thereof.
- ❖ The candidates passed 10+2 examination in science (physics, chemistry & biology) conducted by National institute of open school are also eligible to apply.
- ❖ The candidates must have passed in the subject of PCB & English individually and must have obtained a minimum of 45% marks taken together in PCB at the qualifying examination i.e (10+2). In case of candidates belonging to SC/ST, the marks obtained in PCB taken together in qualifying Examination shall be 40%. English is a compulsory subject in 10+2 for being eligible for admission to B.Sc nursing course.
- ❖ Candidate shall be medically fit for the course.
- ❖ Both female/ male candidates are eligible to apply.

Post Basic B.Sc. (N) (2 years)

- ❖ A candidate seeking admission should have hold a diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery & be a registered Nurse in Odisha Nurses Midwives Council.
- ❖ If the registration certificate cannot be obtained immediately, the original evidence for registration in the form of receipt or any other Authenticated document from the office of the state nursing council will be acceptable in lieu of the registration certificate.
- ❖ The candidate must be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife of ONMRC or equivalent to any other state nursing council.
- ❖ Candidate shall be medically fit for the course.
- ❖ There shall be no upper age limit for admission.
- ❖ The in-service candidates must have obtained a “No objection certificate” from concerned appointing authority.

M.Sc.(N) (2 years)

- ❖ Candidate should be a Registered Nurse and Registered midwife of equivalent with any State Nursing Registration Council.
- ❖ Minimum education requirements shall be the passing of: B.Sc. Nursing/B.Sc. Hons. Nursing/Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing with minimum of 55% aggregate marks.
- ❖ Minimum one year of work experience after Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- ❖ Minimum one year of work experience prior or after Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing.
- ❖ Candidates shall be medically fit.
- ❖ There shall be no upper age limit for admission.
- ❖ The in-service candidates must have obtained a “No objection certificate” from concerned appointing authority.
- ❖ Both female/ male candidates are eligible to apply.

Specialities :-

1. Medical Surgical Nursing
2. Child Health Nursing
3. Obstetrics & Gynaecological Nursing
4. Community Health Nursing
5. Mental Health Nursing

DMRT (2 years)

- ❖ Must have passed +2 Science or Equivalent examinations with Biology as one of the subjects.
- ❖ The candidates should have completed 17 years of age as on 31st December of the year in which admission is sought. The maximum age limit for admission shall be 35 years.
- ❖ The candidates should not pursue any other regular course simultaneously with the DMLT / DMRT course if admitted. An undertaking should be submitted during admission.

Admission Procedure

Candidates should submit the prescribed application form duly completed along with requisite documents. Documents required at the time of admission:

1. Certificate of passing the qualifying examination.
2. Original mark sheet of H.S.C.
3. Original mark sheet of S.S.C./S.S.L.C.
4. Transfer Certificate or School Leaving Certificate, Migration certificate original.
5. Caste certificate issued by the competent authority, if admission is against reserved category.
6. Character/Conduct Certificate.
7. Aadhaar Card, Voter ID.
8. Certificate of change of name, if applicable supported by documentary evidence like government Gazette.
9. Gap certificate.
10. Experience Certificate (For M.Sc Nursing).
11. B.Sc(N)/P.B.B.Sc (N) Degree Certificate (For M.Sc Nursing).
12. B.Sc(N)/P.B.B.Sc (N) first year to final year mark sheets (For M.Sc Nursing).
13. Registration Certificate (For PB B.Sc & M. Sc Nursing).
14. GNM Degree Certificate & Mark Sheet (For PB B.Sc Nursing).

Anti-Ragging Policy

Co-Curricular Activities


